

Dow Jones Sukuk Indices Consultation Results

NEW YORK, JUNE 19, 2017: S&P Dow Jones Indices has conducted a consultation with members of the investment community on potential changes to the Dow Jones Sukuk Indices and the Dow Jones Sukuk Higher Quality Investment Grade Select Total Return Index.

Effective prior to the market open on Monday, July 3, 2017, in conjunction with the implementation of the July 2017 rebalancing, S&P Dow Jones Indices will make the following methodology change to the indices.

Consultation feedback received was favorable for the change being implemented. Feedback for the proposed middle credit rating change to the Dow Jones Sukuk Higher Quality Investment Grade Select Total Return Index was unfavorable for implementation at this time and the proposed change will not be made.
